



Information about Processing Personal Data of Visitors at TATRA TRUCKS a.s.

Data Controller

The controller of personal data is TATRA TRUCKS a.s., with registered office at Areál Tatro 1450/1, 74 221 Kopřivnice, ID: 014 82 840, registered in the Commercial Register kept by the Regional Court in Ostrava, Section B, File 10443 (hereinafter referred to as TT).

Purpose of Personal Data Processing

The processing of personal data aims to control and process visitor information to facilitate entry or access to the TT premises. This is particularly done to ensure the safety and protection of TT's property, employees, visitors, and to address any exceptional (damage) events and assert claims arising from the visit.

Processed Personal Data

- 1) Name, surname, company, type and number of identification document, phone number, email
- 2) Purpose of visit
- 3) In case of entry to the TT premises: plate number and vehicle type
- 4) Records of visitor movements captured by the camera and access system

Data Processing Period

Visitor personal data is processed for a period of 5 years.
Camera records are retained as necessary for each specific location.

Legal Basis and Obligation to Provide Personal Data

Processing personal data is in the legitimate interests of TT for the following reasons:

- 1) Ensuring the safety, health protection, and property protection of TT and its employees, as well as visitors themselves.
- 2) Addressing potential exceptional (damaging) events and asserting claims arising from the respective visit.

The processing of personal data is based on the legitimate interests of TT for ensuring safety, health protection, and property protection of TT and its employees, as well as visitors. Providing personal data is voluntary, but the data is essential for proper registration, and failure to provide it may result in denied access to the TT premises.

Automated Decision-Making

TT processes personal data manually and through automated means. Automated decision-making or profiling is not used in personal data processing.

Security of Processed Personal Data

Personal data protection is ensured through technical and personnel measures in accordance with relevant legal regulations. Personal data is under constant physical and electronic control, utilizing modern control, technical, and security mechanisms to prevent unauthorized access, transmission, loss, destruction, or misuse.

Rights of Data Subjects

In accordance with relevant legal regulations, especially Articles 15-21 of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), the visitor has the right to:

- 1) Access and portability of their personal data
- 2) Correction of inaccurate or incomplete personal data
- 3) Object to the processing of their data (in accordance with Article 21 GDPR)
- 4) Lodge a complaint directly with the Office for Personal Data Protection (www.uoou.cz)
- 5) Erasure of personal data or restriction of their processing
